HOW TO PERFORM THE ALLERGY ALERT TEST:



Remove earrings. Behind the ear and using a cotton-bud, apply a little of the unmixed colourant product sufficient to cover an area of 1 to 2 cm2 (e.g. the size of a small coin). Re-apply allowing it to dry between applications. Carefully reseal the colourant container. Leave for 48 hours without washing, covering or

If during this period you or your client notice any abnormal reactions, such as itching, redness or swelling in or around the test area, DO NOT APPLY THE PRODUCT.

IN CASE OF A REACTION DURING THE APPLICATION such as intense stinging, irritation, rash or burning sensation on the scalp, rinse immediately and discontinue use. In case of shortness of breath, seek immediate medical attention.

1. PREPARATION:

. Wear suitable disposable gloves. Use exclusively with the recommended oxidants, 6 volume (1.8%), 9 volume (2.7%) or 15 volume (4.5%) maximum. / Do not use with hydrogen peroxide greater than 15 volume (4.5%). • Use only the proportions indicated. . When a shaker is used, open immediately after mixing to avoid the shaker bursting and damage from the product overflowing. In a bowl, applicator bottle or shaker, . Pour 50 ml (1 tube) of Diarichesse cream colourant, . Add 75 ml of Diactivateur 6 vol. (1.8%), 9 vol. (2.7%) or 15 vol. (4.5%), depending on the desired result.
