OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This dryer has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than

the other). As a safety feature; this plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit securely, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

CHECK SAFETY PLUG CIRCUIT INTERRUPTOR EVERY TIME YOU USE DRYER

This dryer is equipped with a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI), a safety feature that will not allow the dryer to operate, in the event of immersion in water. To make sure the GFCI is functioning properly, check the safety plug:

Simply place the plug into the outlet and press the test button. The dryer should immediately stop. To resume operating the dryer, press the reset button.

MAINTENANCE

The dryer is virtually maintenance free. No lubrication is needed. Keep all vents and openings clear of dirt and dust. The exterior of the dryer should be wiped clean with a damp cloth only.

Blocked or clogged air intake vents will cause the dryer to overheat. If overheating occurs an automatic safety device will shut off the dryer. If this occurs, unplug the cord and allow the dryer to cool for 10 to 15 minutes before starting. Make sure the air vents are clean.

STORAGE

When not in use, your dryer should be disconnected and stored in a safe, dry location, out of reach of children. Never wrap the cord around the dryer. Allow the cord to hang loose and straight at the point of entry

into the dryer.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be taken, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING, KEEP AWAY FROM WATER

DANGER: As with most electrical appliances, electrical parts are electrically live even when the switch is off:
