Wella Color Touch Sunlights

Recommended mixing:

- always mix the Color Touch Sunlights dye with the 4% Color Touch emulsion

a ratio of 1:2 (for example 30 g of cream + 60 g of emulsion)

mix the Color Touch Sunlights dye in a plastic bowl; do not mix it with dyes from another collection (Color Touch, Koleston Perfect)

Application:

- wear gloves

apply Color Touch Sunlights to unwashed hair and apply

it along the entire length of the hair from the roots to the ends

the reaction time: 20 minutes without the application of heat or 15 minutes on hair which has been dyed with a permanent hair dye/ironed

the reaction time: 15 minutes with the application of heat (Climazon2) or 10 minutes on hair which has been dyed with a permanent hair dye/ironed

you can extend the reaction time by 5 minutes if necessary

Dyeing roots:

Only apply to the roots of the hair.

Matching the colour of the hair along its entire length to the ends:

Apply the Color Touch Sunlights dye along the entire length of the hair up to the ends. The additional reaction time: 5-10 minutes

Subsequent care:

wash your hair thoroughly with hot water once the reaction time is over

wash your hair with Wella Professionals shampoo for dyed hair

use SP 3.8 Color Save Emulsion or Lifetex Color protective foam to fix the dye.
